Mainstreets Masterclass

The Property Council Of Australia's Mainstreets Advocacy Committee will host a Mainstreets master class/workshop with a specific focus on regional Mainstreets. The social, cultural and economic stability of our Mainstreets continue to play an important role in defining our towns, cities and communities.

The Committee was formed back in 2011 to bring greater awareness to our State's Mainstreets and to work on developing and highlighting best practice measures that can be adopted by Mainstreet participants.

Over the last few years, the Committee has released two editions of "Mainstreets – A Best Practice Guide". This year's event and associated outcomes will contribute towards a regional Mainstreets guide to be produced later in the year.
